Dear Parents/Carers,

We have recently purchased an online subscription to Collins Big Cat E-books and we will shortly be sending you information via Dojo about how to access this using your child's unique log in details. Once you receive this information (it will be sent through to you in a Dojo message by the end of the week), please log in to access the levelled books that your child's class teacher has allocated to you. These books will be 'live' and ready for you to access from the afternoon of Friday 12th February. Please note that if you log in before this date, the books will not yet be allocated to your child.

These books have been selected based on the most recent assessments completed in school so should match your child's ability well. For our younger children, these texts are streamlined to our phonics scheme and will be very familiar to you as they match the books we send home from school. If you have concerns over the level of the text set, please contact your child's class teacher to give them the information and they will work with you to review this.

We hope that this facility will enable you to enjoy levelled books that are designed to aid reading progress with your child during the lockdown period. We know that reading regularly is highly important in a child's progress and development, so we hope that you will be able to access these books over the half term break in order to keep your child's reading skills developing. For our younger children it is good practice for the children to read the books more than once so please don't feel that you need to rush through the books available.

Teachers will be able to review which books have been read and will appreciate any feedback you give them about how your child has got on with their reading. Moving forward after half term, they will then be able to set new books for you to enjoy.
